- A drop in program that focuses on academic upscaling and career development
- Includes various workshops and activities that support individuals in their ability to graduate and find work after high school, such as: resume writing, positive relationships building, and homework assistance
- Key Mentor role: building relationships, supporting program implementation, and helping with homework
- Tuesdays & Thursdays from 4-6pm at the Youth Centre

**Volunteers Currently Needed in ABACUS Program:**

- Program focuses on improving the academic, community and environmental factors that most directly affect a student's likelihood of continuing his or her education
- The goal of the program is to improve high school graduation rates and access to post-secondary education by focusing on the middle-school years: Grades 6, 7, 8 and transition to 9
- Key Mentor role: building relationships and supporting individuals with program activities
- Mondays & Wednesdays from 6-8pm at Ellis (Kiwanis)

**Volunteers Currently Needed in ABACUS Lift Off Program:**

- To build up an individual's ability to read and write, focusing on grades 4 to 5.
- Program is a combination of activities, games, and reading that is geared to develop literacy skills in a logical and appropriate manner
- Key Mentor role: Supporting program implementation and helping individuals read
- Fridays from 6-8pm at Ellis (Kiwanis)

**Volunteer Roles & Responsibilities:**

- Assist in set up and take down of program equipment
- Lift equipment, when necessary (tables and chairs)
- Provide support to instructors with program delivery which may include actively participating
- Support youth with 1:1 with guidance and instruction
- Be a positive role model to participants in the program
- Spend time creating connections with youth as a caring adult
- Seek clarification and guidance from BGC staff when needed
- Familiarize with and follow all policies, procedures and emergency protocols
