**Volunteers Currently Needed in Full Day Child Care:**

- Tasks include engaging with young children, cleaning/sanitizing, setting up/assisting with activities, swimming Friday mornings and outdoor play
- Sites needing volunteers:
  - Ellis (Kiwanis) Club,
  - Queen Mary Elementary School, and
  - Prince of Wales Elementary School
- Monday through Friday, full- or part-time shifts available
- At the Ellis and Queen Mary sites, there is swimming with the children on Fridays at 10:00 am.

**Volunteers Currently Needed in Summer Camp:**

- Tasks include engaging with children aged 6-12, cleaning/sanitizing, setting up/assisting with activities, engaging in outdoor play, swimming, and going on field trips
- Schools needing volunteers for camp are:
  - Queen Mary,
  - Viscount Montgomery, and
  - Prince of Wales
- Monday through Friday, full- or part-time shifts available

**Volunteer Requirements:**

- Regularly scheduled volunteers are required to provide:
  - Doctor’s approval for working with children
  - Tuberculosis test results
